1. FIG Working Week 2023, Orlando, Florida

It was great to see so much interest for C7 in the submissions for Orlando. We had over **150 abstracts** submitted for C7 (with some linked to multiple Commissions). The quality was also high! Fitting all these all into the program is of course a challenge – but we're working on it (with the support of Working Group Chairs, and the other Commissions). 2. International Workshop on Integration and Decentralisation, Nepal, 16-17 February

FIG C7 (along with C2) were very glad to co-organise an international workshop on the integration and decentralisation of land administration and land use planning functions, February 16-17, in Dhulikhel, Nepal. New FIG President, Diane Dumashie, delivered an online presentation during the Opening Ceremony. Decentralisation empowers local communities to shape landscapes and settlements, and is enabled by more readily available access to land information and geospatial tools and technologies (amongst other things). However, it comes with challenges of ensuring national data integration, intergovernmental

coordination, and provision of adequate skills and capacity to local levels. Nepal was the ideal location for the event, as it strives to implement its Land Use Policy (2015). Nepal's, Land Management Training Center (LMTC), headed by Mr. Ganesh Bhatta, provided a wonderful and productive experience for all delegates.
